I have just attempted to serve the summons on Mr Jeremy Greenwood at the two addresses, below is a summary of my attempts:

- I approached the premises at approximately 11.10 am. It is residential building with a narrow secure lobby between two commercial buildings.
- The lobby door was open so I walked in and was able to get into the elevator however you need a swipe card or be 'buzzed' into the building to gain access to the floors.
- I proceeded to exit the building and dialled could see me but I could not see her).

- It was difficult to hear the intercom over nearby construction noise however I asked if I could see Mr Greenwood and was informed that no one by the name of Jeremy Greenwood resides in number .
- I asked for her name which she declined to give.
- I thanked her for her time and left the premises.
- I approached the premises at approximately 11.15 am (it is almost directly opposite t).
- It is a residential building with a secure lobby.
- I dialled on the video intercom. The call appeared to be answered after the first ring as the bell stopped ringing so I asked for Mr Greenwood however there was no response and the call appeared to time out.
- I redialled the number which once again appeared to be answered, I asked for Mr Greenwood, once again there was no response and the call appeared to have been ended by another party.
- I left the premises and called the inquiry Director to seek advice and given the potential discrepancy between the first and second attempts to serve the summons I was asked to try again.
- I reapproached the premises at approximately 11.38 am, dialled and the video intercoms rang once and approximately 5 seconds later the call was ended.
- I left the premises at approximately 11.39 am.
